



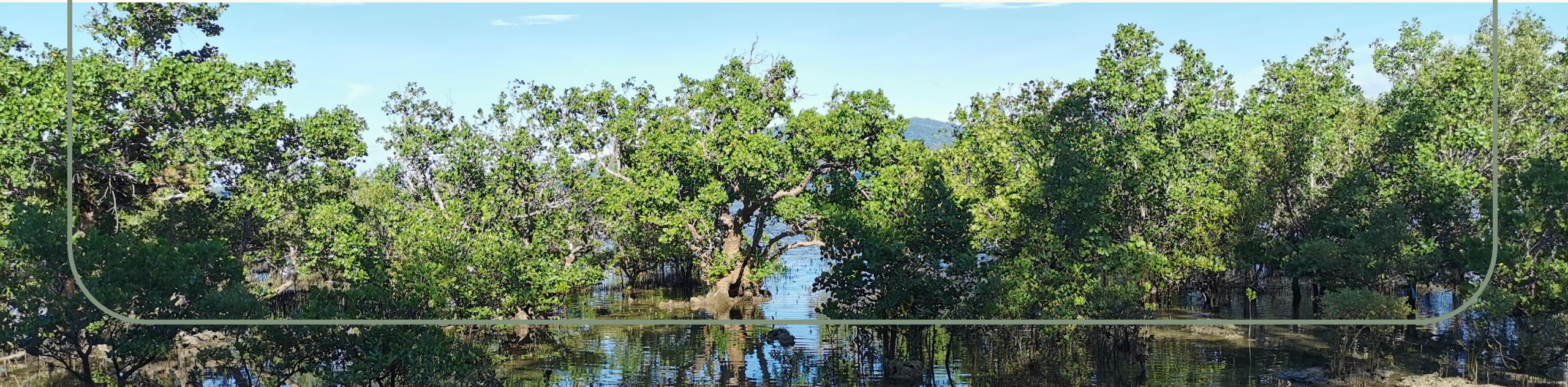


Nenorte Samarnon for harmony and working together; coming from the root word *sayô* (*usa*) or one.

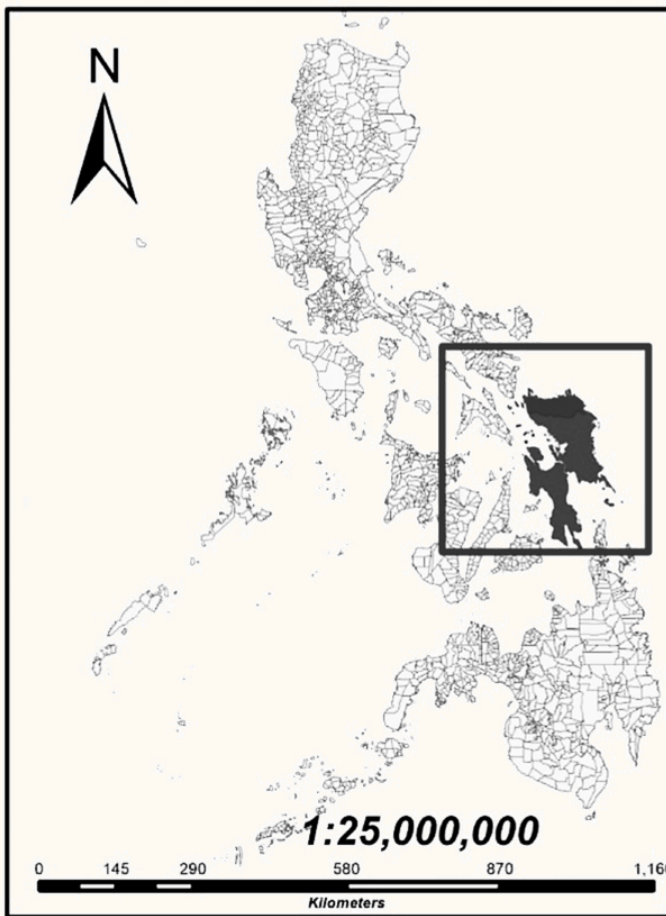
